In 1997, Anthony Martinez was kidnapped from the back alley of his Beaumont home while playing with friends. His body was found 14 days later in a desert canyon in Indio. His killer, Joseph Duncan, was arrested in 2005 for killing a family in Idaho. He kidnapped the two youngest children, imprisoning them for 6 weeks. After killing the boy, Duncan was arrested at Denny's in Idaho with the boy's sister. He is suspected of killing two young girls in Washington in 1996.
